## Approaches to Learning

Students will show growth in creativity, imagination, and curiosity.

## Language & Literacy



**Students will communicate verbally and non-verbally to express themselves through speaking, listening, reading and writing.**

Students will develop early reading, writing, and communication skills.

## Social & Emotional Development



**The Conscious Discipline school family culture will encourage healthy social-emotional development.**

Students will gradually regulate their feelings, develop an awareness of feelings of others, and be a part of the classroom community.

## Cognition



**Students will develop problem solving skills in intentional classroom environments.**
